





India's wedding industry has experienced remarkable growth in recent years, with luxury celebrations taking centre stage

he Indian wedding market is expanding at an unprecedented pace, particularly in the luxury segment, fueled by a growing affluent population and evolving consumer aspirations. The sector is projected to grow by 6.5-7% annually in 2025, with high-end fashion, bespoke experiences, and immersive shopping playing pivotal roles in this surge.

In 2024, an estimated 4.8 million weddings were held, generating a staggering \$70.4 billion in revenue. Notably, 9% of these weddings had budgets exceeding ₹1 crore, with over 60% of them being destination weddings, an indicator of the rising preference for opulent, experience-driven nuptials.

As per the latest reports, the Indian wedding industry is currently valued at approximately ₹10.79 lakh crore, nearly double the size of the U.S. wedding market. Today's Traveller takes a deep dive into some of the factors behind the meteoric rise of ultra-luxury Indian weddings

### THE WEDDING AS A SPECTACLE

In India, weddings are more than just a celebration; they are a statement of wealth, power, and social stature. What was once a deeply personal affair has evolved into a grand spectacle, where opulence knows no bounds. The past decade has witnessed an unprecedented rise in ultra-luxury weddings, featuring multi-day celebrations at palatial venues, Michelinstarred catering, world-renowned entertainers, and couture ensembles that rival royal wardrobes. This transformation mirrors India's economic boom and the ever-growing influence of globalisation, redefining weddings as extravagant, multi-million-pound affairs.

Indian weddings have traditionally been elaborate, with rituals spanning several days. However, the scale and execution of modern ultra-luxury weddings have reached heights previously unseen. According to a 2023 report by KPMG India, the Indian wedding industry is valued at over

eddings have evolved into cultural showcases, statement pieces, and sometimes full-blown theatrical productions. And leading this grand performance? The food, of course. Gone are the days when weddings were measured by the size of the guest list or the sparkle of the bride's jewellery. Now, they're judged by the truffle oil content in the hors d'oeuvres, the Instagram-worthiness of the dessert table, and how well the cocktails paired with the mehendi theme.

Globally and across India, the wedding banquet has moved from being a functional necessity to a curated experience. Food is no longer just eaten, it's unveiled, performed, photographed, personalised, and, occasionally, flamed at the table by someone in a chef's hat with artistic tendencies.

Let's take a closer look at what's trending on the world's fanciest wedding plates - and how India, in true dramatic fashion, is leading a culinary revolution of its own.

### **INDIA GOES BIG**

Indian weddings are epic productions with prequels, sequels, and a star-studded cast that includes caterers, decorators, and that cousin who insists on dancing solo. Food has always been central. What's changed is the scale and the serious culinary ambition.

Chefs like Manish Mehrotra and Thomas Zacharias are reshaping Indian food aesthetics by keeping the soul intact, but dressing it in haute couture. Grandma's recipe now wears a bowtie and gets served on a ceramic slate.

### **CURATED FOOD CONCEPTS**

Gone are the days when all wedding meals were indistinguishable versions of "North Indian Buffet + One Chinese Counter". The modern wedding menu now comes with mood boards. Mehendi brunches mix vada pav sliders with sushi pani puri; haldi ceremonies serve dosa skewers and banana fritters.

Planners now treat food like couture where every function is a runway show, "Royal Rajasthani" welcome dinners, "Tokyo Nights" sangeets, and "Temple Feasts" with brass cutlery and QR-coded menus. Menus set the mood, spark conversations, and guarantee at least one debate about who had the better canapé: the bride's side or the groom's.

### **SWEET STATEMENTS**

Bars at Indian weddings have been seriously upgraded. What used to be whisky and soda is now saffron gin with 12 tonic pairings, cold brew espresso stations, and pop-up champagne carts that roll out just before the pheras. Someone always cheers - sometimes even the bride's grandfather.

Mocktails are getting the same love: masala chai with

cinnamon foam, tender coconut coolers in glassware that costs more than the return gift, and saffron milk with a brûléed top. Hydration has become a lifestyle choice.

### **TECH TAKES OVER**

Spreadsheets and software are now vital guests at the table. Guest preferences, dietary restrictions, and even portion sizes are tracked in real-time. Apps allow chefs to tweak menus on the fly. Menus are accessed by QR codes, and some weddings even offer WhatsApp polls so guests can vote for their favourite dish before dessert arrives.

It's a data-driven buffet where nothing goes to waste — and everything gets logged. Even the fact that six people requested Jain sushi. Yes, that happened.

### **FOOD AS THEATRE**

No one's standing in line for soggy pasta anymore. Instead, guests are being handed fresh oysters by chefs who moonlight as magicians. In Paris, shucking stations are now accompanied by champagne sabrage. In Bali, vegan sushi


